GENERAL INFORMATION

- Contest Dates: November 12 through December 31, 2022
- Student Contestants include children in grades K-12 who live in Crestwood, are relatives of those who work, live, or worship in Crestwood, or who attend Lindbergh Schools or any school in Crestwood
- Adult Contestants include anyone 18 years or older who are not eligible for a student group, and who now or in the past lived, worked, played, or worshiped in Crestwood
- Four categories with one winner in each category: students in grades K-3, 4-6, or 7-12 and Adults age 18 and older
- Prizes include age-appropriate goods and services from Crestwood Businesses with a minimum value over \$200.*
- All essays must be received or postmarked by 5:00 pm on Saturday, December 31, 2022
- Winners will be notified in January, 2023
- Essays will be reviewed and winners will be determined by the Crestwood Aldermen, City Administrator, and Mayor
- Prizes will be presented to category winners at a Board of Aldermen meeting in January, 2023

- Student Contestants should write a 1- to 2-page essay
